THE BORING BUT ESSENTIAL STUFF!

The camp is designed for anyone, 12 years or older, who wishes to learn the art of fly fishing. Most of the emphasis will be on teaching the beginner fly fisher the necessary skills to catch fish. However, many students enjoy the course (and the general camaraderie that abounds) that they return year after year, so we also run a more advanced course for intermediate students.

Students aged 12-14 (at the commencement date of the school) - we require that a parent or guardian must also be enrolled in the same course level.

Students aged 14-17 - we require that they have a parent or guardian on site for the duration of the course.

We base our camp on the southern lakes system at Bronte Lagoon on private property. As the camp is of a self-sufficient nature, campers are expected to supply their own tents/vans, sleeping bags, food and cooking equipment, fishing tackle and equipment. Temporary portable toilets are provided for the course dates. A basic list of fishing necessities as well as other relevant information will be issued upon receipt of your registration fees.

Beginner students are provided with a free comprehensive manual upon registration at the school. Additional notes are handed out in most sections of the course, so students have something to refer to long after the camp has completed.

PLEASE NOTE: Enrolment fee does not include fishing licence.

All students 14 and over need to hold a fishing license.

Intermediate students - *please ensure your membership fees are paid BEFORE registering for the school as your camp fee does not include membership fees.*
